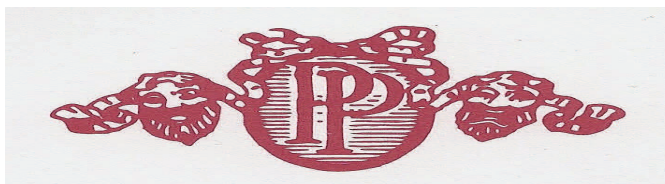

A Message from the President

Some of us thought, and for good reason, that we should move the Annual Show to November 2014 and change the venue to the Baltimore Country Club. This suggestion was met with mixed emotions and mixed opinions. So, we put a process in motion that unfolded as follows...

Members were invited to express their opinions at the General Membership Meeting and at several Board Meetings. Some voiced their support for changing the date and venue of the Show while some voiced their opposition. I received phone calls and emails on the subject and listened to some rather good arguments on both sides. Some lively discussions took place, but all in all the discussions were respectful and intelligent. In the meantime, there was a committee working in the background, putting aside personal feelings and opinions and dealing with just the facts. This committee was charged with exploring ALL options, focusing specifically on the financial feasibility of holding the Show at BCC. The committee UNANIMOUSLY concluded that we could not make BCC work financially at this time, and presented their findings to me. End-of-discussion!

A couple of months ago we talked about this year being a transitional year where we would change the President's term of office from a fiscal year to a calendar year to accommodate the Show changing dates. This is no longer necessary. My term as President which began in July 2013 will end at the July 2014 Board meeting at which time I will turn the gavel over to Judy Kahl to begin her one year term as President.

We put the strength and integrity of our Club to the test and we emerged with a decision that reflects the intelligence and professionalism on which we pride ourselves.



Thanks to Buzz, Bernie, Judy, Marge and Carolyn for serving on this ad hoc committee to determine when and where the Show will be held. And thanks to each member who expressed an opinion on the subject.

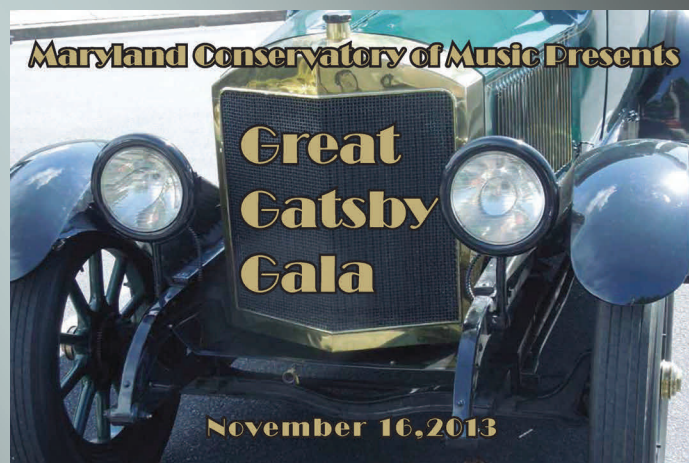

The deadline for receipt of the Charity Selection Check-Off Sheet has been extended to Friday October 25, 2013.

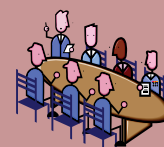
