Please prepare your brief responses to the following...


- I. Name of your show, what was your part in the show?

standards, patriotic music, and a little rock and roll. Our performances are free to the public. Donations are happily accepted, with a portion of the proceeds going to Linwood.




Ken has this warm and infectious smile. He made me feel like I was someone who mattered. I knew then that the P&P Club was something special.
