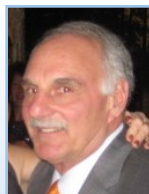

AMENDMENT TO BY-LAWS RELATING TO NON-RESIDENT PAST PRESIDENTS

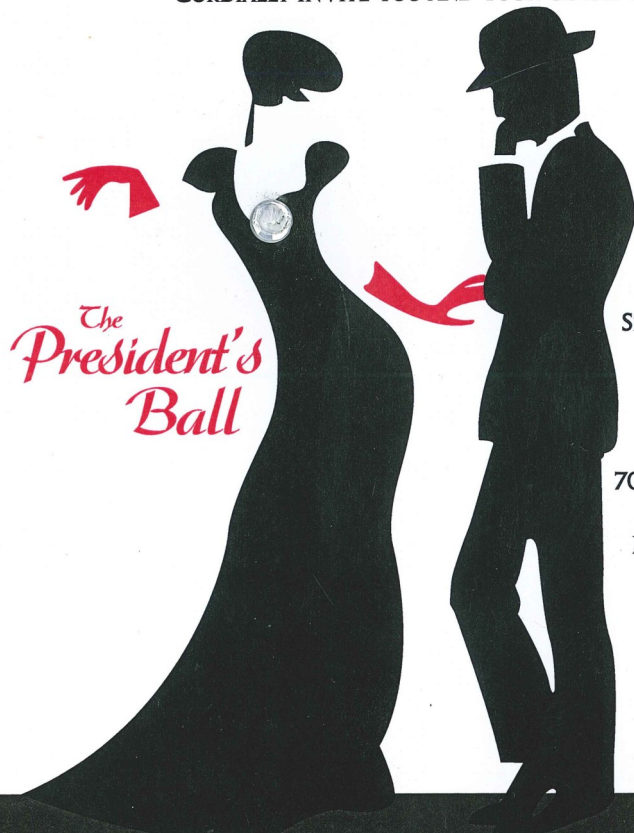
The Board of Governors, at its meeting on February 9, 2016, voted to amend the By-Laws by adding the following subparagraph E to said Section 9 of ARTICLE V:

“E. Any Past President of the Club who becomes a non-resident of Maryland, or who resides in Maryland but outside of a 75 mile radius of Baltimore City, shall be designated an “Honorary Member” and shall then have the option of either being free from payment of dues, or continuing to remain a voting member and pay dues in accordance with Article V, Section 6 of these By-Laws”

This By-Law amendment is effective immediately; however it may be repealed or altered by the general membership at the next meeting of the members to be held on June 15, 2016 at the L'Hirondelle County Club.
